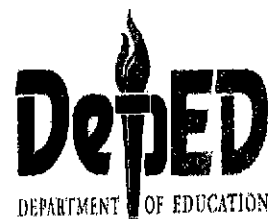

Entry qualifications

Elementary and junior high school children (Children aged between six and fifteen years .)

Requirements of exhibits

Theme: Free (Artwork should be flat, picture frames should not be used)

Type: Watercolors, crayons, pastel crayons, wood prints etc.

Size: Maximum 36.4 × 51.1 cm

Number of exhibits: Entries are limited to one per person, and up to 20 per city, 10 cities per country, in principle, due to space limitations at the exhibition site. If these limits are exceeded, the artworks will be screened and some may not be exhibited.

Ownership: The ownership and copyright of the exhibits will belong to the promoter.

Other: Exhibits will be kept carefully and utilized for an indefinite period of time, therefore, artwork will not be returned.

Application procedure

- (1) Fill in the Exhibit form and attach it to the back of the artwork.
- (2) The Exhibits List should be filled in according to school or group and be presented with the pictures.
- (3) The prizes for the exhibits will be sent to the schools or groups. Please fill in the required information in English letters and in CAPITALS and be careful not to make any mistakes.

Closing date for application

August 31,2004

Please abide by the closing date to avoid any delay in exhibition preparations.
