
SEAMEO-RELC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR LANGUAGE TEACHERS
FOR ACADEMIC YEAR (AY) 2005-2006

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. The Department of Education (DepED), through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) is now accepting nominees for the SEAMEO-RELC Scholarship in Singapore for Academic Year (AY) 2005-2006.
2. Each school/city division may submit two (2) nominees for any of the following courses:
 - Course 103: Post Diploma in Applied Linguistics
 - Course 244: Specialist Certificate in Information Technology in Language Education
 - Course 242: Specialist Certificate in Language Curriculum and Materials Development
 - Course 243: Specialist Certificate in the Teaching of English Grammar
 - Course 241: Specialist Certificate in Language Testing and Assessment
3. Two (2) more slots/places are being offered at special concessionary rate of 50% off the course fees (registration and tuition fees) which may be borne by the local or personal funds of the nominee.
4. Nominees must be in excellent health and should not be more than 45 years of age. He/She must have a working knowledge of computers and good at spoken and written English to get the maximum benefit of the course.
5. Deadline for the submission of nominations and supporting documents such as transcript of records, performance rating of the last three years, service record, medical certificate from a government physician, certificate of no pending administrative or criminal case, personal data sheet (CS Form 212), photocopy of baccalaureate diploma and the endorsement from the School Principal, School/City Division Superintendent and Regional Director, shall be on or before January 28, 2005.
