**DepED MEMORANDUM**

*Intel® Teach to the Future 2005 Summer Activities  
Enhancement Workshop for Selected Regional & Master Trainers  
and  
Training for Master Trainers of Selected Schools*

To: Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents  
Heads, Public Secondary Schools

1. One of the major directions of Philippine education is the integration of information technology in secondary education. To assist teachers in building their capacity, Intel® Technology Philippines, Inc. (ITPI), in coordination with the Department of Education (DepED), Foundation for Information Technology Education Development, Inc. (FIT-ED), and UP National Institute for Science and Mathematics Education Development (UP NISMED) shall conduct the following activities in May 2005:

- a) *ITTF Enhancement Workshop for selected Intel® Teach to the Future Regional and Master Trainers.* The 5-day Enhancement Workshop for Selected Intel® Teach to the Future Regional and Master Trainers aims to enhance the knowledge and skills of the participants on the pedagogical themes of the Intel® Teach to the Future Program and plan for the Intel® Teach to the Future Master Trainers Training for selected schools.

**Luzon Cluster:** Regions III, IVA, and NCR

Date: May 9-13, 2005

Venue: Information Science Laboratory, UP NISMED, UP Diliman, Quezon City

Accommodation: UP NISMED Hostel, UP Diliman, Q.C.

**Mindanao Cluster:** Regions IX, X, XI, XII, and ARMM

Date: May 9-13, 2005

Venue & Accommodation: To be arranged. Participants shall be notified thru their Regional IT Coordinator on the final arrangement of the venue and accommodation.

- b) *ITTF Training for Master Trainers of Selected Schools*. The 10-day Training for Master Trainers aims to help teachers enhance student learning by training them on how to effectively utilize the potentials of technology in the subject they teach.

2. Participants to ITTF 2005 Summer Activities are as follows:
- a) The Enhancement Workshop is for selected Intel® Teach to the Future Regional and Master Trainers and 3 DepEd – Central Office BSE Staff listed in the Enclosure. The selected participants shall confirm their attendance *one (1) week* before the activity with their Regional IT Coordinator or with Mr. Edward Garcia, SDD-BSE at telefax number (02) 632-7586. Participants are expected to register on May 8, 2005.
  - b) The Training for Master Trainers is for selected secondary Mathematics, Science, and/or English teachers from selected schools. The selection of participating schools and teachers for the said ITTF Training for Master Trainers shall be done by FIT-ED, in coordination with the DepEd Regional and Division Offices concerned. The final list of participants and further information about this MT Training will be disseminated thru the Regional IT coordinator. Participants are expected to be at the training venue a day before the start of the activity.
3. UP NISMED shall be the trainers for the first batch of MT Training while the selected Regional and Master Trainers listed in the Enclosure shall be the trainers and facilitators for the second batch of MT Training.
4. Arrangement for the accommodation, meals, and transportation are as follows:

- a) Intel<sup>®</sup> shall pay for the meals, accommodation, and the cost of the Enhancement Workshop while traveling expenses of the Regional and Master Trainers and the 3 DepEd – Central Office BSE Staff shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
  - b) Intel<sup>®</sup> shall pay for the cost of the MT Training, and partially subsidize the meals and accommodation, while traveling expenses of participants and trainers shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Participants to the ITTF Summer Activities are expected to conduct a school-based training for 20 other teachers in their respective schools.
  6. Immediate dissemination of the Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
