ORIENTATION/TRAINING WORKSHOP ON THE PILOT IMPLEMENTATION
OF THE THIRD YEAR CURRICULAR OFFERINGS OF THE REVISED
REGIONAL SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOLS (RSHS) CURRICULUM

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Regional Science High Schools

1. The Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), through the Curriculum Development Division (CDD), shall conduct an Orientation/Training Workshop on the Pilot Implementation of the Third Year Curricular Offerings of the Revised Regional Science High Schools Curriculum on May 15-21, 2005 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City.
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. orient participants on the revised Regional Science High Schools Curriculum (Third year);
 - b. update participants on the content and strategies in teaching the additional subjects and electives offered in the Third Year; and
 - c. develop non-traditional assessment.
3. The participants shall be the following: one (1) school head of each RSHS and one (1) teacher in each of the following subjects: Math III-Pre Calculus and Trigonometry, Advanced Statistics, Physics, Zoology and Linear Algebra. The RSHS principal/teacher participants are requested to bring at least one laptop preferably with CD Drive and references in their respective subject areas.
4. The opening ceremonies shall be at 6:30 p.m. on May 15. The first meal to be served is dinner of same day.
5. Travel expenses, per diems and other incidental expenses of regional participants from official station shall be charged against local funds. Honoraria of consultants, extra duty allowance of BSE Management Staff, board and lodging of the regional participants and BSE Management Staff, travel expenses, per diems and other incidental expenses of BSE Management Staff relative to the activity shall be charged against OSEC Funds (Operational Expenses of the RSHSs), subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
