

E-TRAINING FOR SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS TEACHERS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents  
Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

1. The Department of Science and Technology (DOST), through the Science Education Institute (SEI) in collaboration with the University of the Philippines through the Open University and selected e-Training Network Institutions nationwide, announces the implementation of the e-Training for Science and Mathematics Teachers.
2. The e-Training for Science and Mathematics Teachers is an on-line training designed to upgrade the competencies of science and mathematics teachers in the elementary and secondary levels.
3. The subject areas to be offered are as follows:
  - a. Elementary Science Grades 3 - 6
  - b. Elementary Math Grades 3 - 6
  - c. Secondary General Science
  - d. Secondary Biology
  - e. Secondary Chemistry
  - f. Secondary Physics
  - g. Secondary Math I - IV
4. The participants to the training are teachers teaching science and mathematics subjects in the elementary and secondary levels who must:
  - a. be Filipino citizens teaching in the Philippines;
  - b. be actually teaching the science/mathematics subjects applied for either in public or private schools but is a non-major in that subject;
  - c. have basic computer and internet skills;
  - d. be willing and able to learn on-line (must have reliable access to Internet);
  - e. not have attended any RSTC teacher-training program;
  - f. be committed to teach in the Philippines for at least two (2) years; and
  - g. be willing to sign a scholarship contract with the DOST-SEI.
5. The duration of the training is ten (10) months starting October 2005 to June 2006.

6. On-line training will be conducted by the following e-Training Network Institutions:
  - a. Saint Louis University, Baguio City
  - b. Mariano Marcos State University, Laoag City
  - c. Saint Mary's University, Nueva Vizcaya
  - d. Central State University, City of Munoz, Nueva Ecija
  - e. Philippine Normal University, Manila
  - f. Bicol University, Legazpi City
  - g. West Visayas State University, Iloilo City
  - h. University of San Carlos, Cebu City
  - i. Western Mindanao State University, Zamboanga City
  - j. Xavier University, Cagayan de Oro City
  - k. Ateneo de Davao University, Davao City
  - l. Notre Dame of Marbel University, Cotabato City
  - m. Mindanao State University, Marawi City
7. Qualified and interested applicants may fill out the application forms at this website: [www.set.-dost.gov.ph/e-training](http://www.set.-dost.gov.ph/e-training) or may download the forms and e-mail the accomplished forms to [e-training@sei.dost.gov.ph](mailto:e-training@sei.dost.gov.ph).
8. Application forms must be received at SEI on or before August 6, 2005.
9. The participants to the training will receive the Notice of Acceptance on August 15, 2005.
10. The participants for each course will attend a one-day face-to-face orientation at the e-training institutions nearest to their school on October 8, 2005.
11. The participants will be provided with:
  - a. waived training fee of PhP6,000.00 for the duration of the training;
  - b. internet allowance of PhP500.00 per month for 10 months;
  - c. round trip transportation expenses for the orientation session; and
  - d. 50% of the cost of People's PC (if the participant decides to purchase a computer from the Procurement Service of the Department of Budget and Management).
12. A Memorandum of Agreement will be signed regarding the purchase of people's PC between the participant and SEI.
13. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
