

PROJECT Q-LEARN: SCHOOL-BASED QUALITY LEARNING CELLS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents  
Heads, Public and Private Elementary Schools

1. The Department of Education through the Bureau of Elementary Education will conduct the Project q-Learn: School-based Quality Learning Cells from year 2005 to year 2006. The project is funded by the Third Elementary Education Project (TEEP) School Improvement and Innovation Facility (SIIF) National Window. Southeast Asia Ministers of Educational Organization-Innovation and Technology (SEAMEO-INNOTECH) is the service provider.
2. Project q-Learn aims to enhance the competencies of teachers and school administrators on the use of professional self-learning packages designed to enable them to carry out school-based, self-propelled learning activities at their own pace and in their own learning styles. It is envisioned that these competencies shall consequently help improve student achievement in the different learning areas on the Basic Education Curriculum.
3. The Project has the following components:
  - a. Conduct of Developing a Curriculum (DACUM) Workshop to develop the Learning Action Cell (LAC) in-service training competency framework, and identify context-specific professional development learning needs of elementary school teachers and school heads;
  - b. Development of multi-media self-learning packages for the use of teachers and school administrators in their School Learning Action Cell (SLAC) sessions;
  - c. In-service training which has two sub-components: training on the development of self-learning modules, and training on the utilization of self-learning modules; and
  - d. Evaluation of the self-learning modules.
4. Participants to this project are teachers, school administrators, supervisors from the regional, division and district levels and specialists from the Central Office.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
