**17th YMCA NATIONAL ASSEMBLY OF HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS AND 10TH YMCA
NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL CLUB ADVISERS SEMINAR**

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

1. The YMCA of Manila, in coordination with the Department of Education (DepED), will hold its **17th YMCA National Assembly of High School Students and the 10th YMCA National High School Club Advisers Seminar** at Junior Mess, Teachers Camp, Baguio City on November 26-29, 2005.
2. With the theme *"YMCA Leadership: A Key to Social Reforms towards National Progress"*, the Assembly specifically aims to:
 - a. broaden the participants' understanding and appreciation of Christian Leadership;
 - b. encourage them to respond effectively to the present issues and concerns affecting their daily lives and the nation as a whole; and
 - c. challenge the participants to actively promote the spirit of unity and understanding among people.
3. The participants in this Assembly are selected student-leaders and teacher-advisers from different public and private secondary schools nationwide.
4. Arrangements for substitute teachers shall be made to ensure that classes of the teacher-participants will not be disrupted. In cases where schools are not able to get substitutes, swapping of teachers' schedules may be made so that students shall not miss their classes.
5. A registration fee of Three Thousand Three Hundred Ninety Five Pesos (PhP3,395.00) shall be charged each participant to cover meals (starting dinner of November 26 to lunch of November 29), lodging, assembly materials, certificate of attendance and miscellaneous expenses. Deadline of registration will be on November 18 and 21 for provincial and Metro Manila delegates, respectively. Delegates are encouraged to come with clothing fit for Baguio climate, medicines for specific needs, camera and some souvenir items for exchange with other participants.
