**CONTEST MECHANICS**

**A. DRAWING CONTEST**

The drawing should be made on a sheet of white 8.5" x 11" paper (short bond paper) using pencil and crayons only. Each entry must be original, drawn by the entrant and officially submitted by mail or through hand-carry.

Enclosed with the entry should be a paper containing the full name, age, complete address, contact numbers and a photocopy of the current school I.D. of the entrant. Please do not fold the artwork.

**The deadline for the submission of entries is on 14 February 2011.**

**Criteria for judging:**

- a. Originality - 25%
- b. Relevance to the theme - 40%
- c. Creativity and presentation - 35%

**Prizes:**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Prize - Php15,000.00
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize - Php10,000.00
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize - Php5,000.00

**B. ESSAY WRITING CONTEST**

The essay must be in English, encoded (MS-Word format), font size 12, Times New Roman, double-spaced with a minimum of 1,300 words and a maximum of 2,000 words. **Deadline for the submission of entries is on 14 February 2011** email to [pcgg25@gmail.com](mailto:pcgg25@gmail.com). Your email entry will be acknowledged upon receipt. Attached with the entry should be an MS-Word file containing the full name, age, complete address, contact numbers and a scanned copy of the current school I.D. of the entrant.

**Criteria for judging:**

The judges will look for quality essays that merit wide circulation, worthy of publication, and enhance public discourse by providing new analysis, perspectives, judgments or ideas.

- a. Originality and coherence - 40%
- b. Content - 40%
- c. Style and presentation - 20%

**Prizes:**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Prize - Php15,000.00
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize - Php10,000.00
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize - Php5,000.00

**C. SHORT FILM COMPETITION**

Under this category, the following may be submitted:

- a.) Short film about the opinions of students' peers and elders on the virtues and values of EDSA '86;
- b.) Documentary about students' peer group's fight against corruption; or
- c.) A music video about protecting democracy and good government.

*Sources of materials with copyrights (ex.shots and music created by other people) must be cited at the bottom of the screen.*

The entries should be uploaded to vimeo.com or at youtube.com. Email an MS-Word file containing the full name, age, complete address, contact numbers and a scanned copy of the current school I.D. of the entrant along with the link of your video to [pcsu25@gmail.com](mailto:pcsu25@gmail.com). **The Deadline of submission is on 18 February 2011.**

**Criteria:**

- Content management or portrayal and dissemination - 40%
- Creativity and execution - 35%
- Technical aspects - 25%

- 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize - Php10,000.00

## **D. MODEL YOUTH ORGANIZATION CONTEST**

### **Objectives:**

1. To recognize the efforts of youth organizations (YOs) actively involved in governance and in improving the conditions of their communities; and
2. To heighten Filipino youth's sense of idealism by inspiring them to serve as models and promote citizen participation in governance.

### **Qualifications:**

1. Groups, organizations, clubs, and societies comprising at least ten members who are 15 to 24 years old
2. Organizations shall be judged on the basis of a recent and/or current project or program that had/has an impact on the community or target audience and which best reflects the efforts of the youth sector towards good governance
3. The project must have been undertaken in the last twelve months or at least a major portion should have been undertaken on or before the deadline of submission of entries. (Note: A project proposal does not qualify as an entry).

### **Criteria for Judging:**

### **Contest Rules:**

1. Each organization can only submit one entry.
2. Interested organizations should submit a fully accomplished Entry Form together with other requirements. Any false statement in the Entry Form will merit disqualification.
3. Documents relating to the entry must be in English, encoded, Times New Roman, font size 12, single-spaced and printed on a short-size bond paper.
4. Do not attach other documents that are not required for submission. When necessary, the PCGG will request for additional data.
5. Lack of, or non-compliance with, requirements will result in automatic disqualification.
6. The organizers reserve the right to modify, alter or amend the above-stated rules or waive compliance therewith at their sole discretion if such steps are in accordance with the objectives of the contest.
7. All decisions of the PCGG panel of judges are final and irrevocable.

8. All materials submitted shall automatically become the property of the PCGG.
9. Contest entry should be received by the PCGG **on or before 14 February 2011**.

**Prize:** Php 25,000.00

**Requirements:**

The organization shall submit three copies of the following:

1. Accomplished Entry Form. Do not leave any item in the Entry Form unanswered.
2. List of officers, leaders and founders (if any). Please indicate name, position, contact number/s (landline and/or mobile) and email addresses.
3. One-page certification attesting to the existence and veracity of information submitted:
  - a. A certification from the Office of Student Affairs for *In-School Youth Organizations*
  - b. A certification from the barangay for *Community-based, Out-of-School or Working Youth Organizations*,
4. Submit a Profile using the prescribed format below:
  - a. Background of the organization (1/2 page)
  - b. Description of your project/program entry (one page)
  - c. Background of your project entry (1/2 page)
  - d. People/organizations involved in the project or program and their corresponding roles (one page)
  - e. Beneficiaries of the project and how did they benefit from it (1/2 page)
  - f. Future plans for the project (1/2 page)
5. Three to five pages of project documentation (*narrative report, photos, testimonies of partners or beneficiaries*)
6. Email scanned copies of all required documents to [pcgg25@gmail.com](mailto:pcgg25@gmail.com). Your email entry will be acknowledged upon receipt.
