## TRAINING WORKSHOP FOR PROSPECTIVE COMPETENCY-BASED CURRICULUM WRITERS UNDER THE STRENGTHENED TECHNICAL AND VOCATIONAL EDUCATION PROGRAM (STVEP)

1. In line with the continuing efforts of the Department of Education (DepEd) to institutionalize the Strengthened Technical and Vocational Education Program (STVEP) through the implementation of an industry driven-competency based curriculum, the Technical-Vocational Task Force (TVTF) will conduct the **Training Workshop for Curriculum Writers** in two (2) clusters on the following dates and venues with participants coming from the 282 Tech-Voc Schools indicated below:

- 2. The training workshop aims to:
  - a. explain the competency-based curriculum development processes;
  - b. apply the concepts/principles and procedures in developing competency-based curriculum for technical-vocational education; and
  - c. develop sample curriculum with modules of instruction and course design.
- 3. Each region shall nominate four (4) participants from the 282 Technical-Vocational Schools who have tech-voc specialization in arts and trades, agriculture and fishery.



- 4. It is expected that the training will develop competent curriculum writers who will form part of the tech-voc pool of curriculum developers.
- 5. The criteria of selecting participants to this training are as follows:
  - a. must be technical-vocational education teachers/practitioners who are actually teaching the specialization/s where they are recommended;
  - b. must be holders of the National Certification (NC I or NC II);
  - c. must be below 50 years old;
  - d. must have good command of oral and written English communication skills;
  - e. must have acquired basic working computer knowledge and skills; and
  - f. must be physically fit.
- 6. The DepEd Regional Office through the Chief Secondary Education Division/Tech-Voc Coordinator is requested to submit the names of the four (4) participants (per region) coming from the STVEP schools selected based on the set criteria. The deadline for submission of nominees to the TVTF, Central Office is on or before March 4 for the 1<sup>st</sup> cluster) and on March 31, 2011 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> cluster.
- 7. Expenses of the organizing committee, external resource persons such as board and lodging and travelling expenses shall be charged to OSEC Tech-Voc Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 8. The board and lodging of participants shall also be charged to OSEC Technical-Vocational Funds while their travelling expenses to and from the venue shall be charged to local funds. In Cluster 1, they are advised to arrive at the venue in the afternoon of March 6 and leave after breakfast on March 12, 2011, and in Cluster 2, they are advised to arrive at the venue in the afternoon of April 10 and leave after breakfast on April 15, 2011.
- 9. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
