**CAPABILITY BUILDING FOR SPED TEACHERS, ADMINISTRATORS AND SUPERVISORS  
UNDER THE HUMAN RESOURCE TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT**

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. In support of the Department's thrust on improving the quality of education for children with special needs, the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE), Special Education (SPED) Division announces the conduct of the **Capability Building for SPED Teachers, Administrators and Supervisors under the Human Resource Training and Development**.

2. The scholarship program aims to provide the SPED teachers, administrators and supervisors knowledge and skills on various educational programs and interventions appropriate for children with special needs. The program will be conducted in the following selected Centers of Excellence (COEs) beginning April 11, 2011:

**Luzon Area**

Venue : Philippine Normal University (PNU), Taft Avenue, Manila  
Participants : from Regions I, II, III, IV-CALABARZON, IV-MIMAROPA, V, NCR and CAR

**Visayas Area**

Venue : Cebu Normal University (CNU), Cebu City  
Participants : from Regions VI, VII and VIII

**Mindanao Area**

Venue : University of Southeastern Philippines (USP), Davao City  
Participants : from Regions IX, X, XI, XII, Caraga and ARMM

3. Priority nominees shall come from the identified regions/divisions/schools where there is an urgent need for trained SPED teachers (See Enclosure No. 1). These nominees shall be screened by the existing Regional Integrated Scholarship Committee (RISC) based on the criteria set in Enclosure No. 2. The deadline for the submission of nominees to the SPED Division is on March **30**, 2011. The list of candidates together with the documents and the Memorandum of Agreement (Training Contract) duly signed by the proper authorities concerned (See Enclosure No. 3) shall be forwarded to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education, DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City on or before March 30, 2011.

4. The SPED scholars are entitled to their salaries, course tuition fees and a stipend. Travel expenses at the most economical mode of transportation shall also be provided including per diem for two (2) days (1 day before and 1 day after) in going to and from the venue which will be paid on the last week of the course.

### **Guidelines for the Selection of New SPED Scholars**

1. The **Regional Integrated Scholarship Committee (RISC)** shall screen and identify the new teacher-grantees to be considered in the program following a set of criteria.
2. The **RISC** shall submit the list of scholars to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education on or before **March 31, 2011**. The names indicated in the list shall be **final**.
3. The following are the criteria for the selection of nominees for the training courses:
  - A bachelor's degree holder related to the area of scholarship with a grade point average of not lower than **2/ B / 85**
  - Has been a teacher for at least three years under permanent status with a performance rating of at least **Very Satisfactory (VS)**
  - Not more than 45 years old
  - Has no pending administrative case and/or criminal record
  - Has been certified by a government physician to be physically and mentally fit and not pregnant during the scholarship period
  - Has not availed of any scholarship/training program for at least two (2) years
  - Possesses leadership potential, facilitation skills, positive attitude to mentor or coach other teachers in his/her school / division as necessary
  - Can communicate effectively in English
  - Can develop and implement relevant re-entry plan
  - Must have a list of prospective clientele for the organization of a class right after the training.
4. The documents / pertinent papers to be submitted by the nominees to their Regional Integrated Scholarship Committees are as follows:
  - CSC Form 212 (Personal Data Sheet) with a 2"x2" recent photo duly certified by the administrative officer
  - Certified photocopy of the **transcript of records**
  - Form 86 (health certificate) from an accredited government hospital
  - Service Record
  - Endorsement from the superintendent
  - Duly accomplished scholarship contract between the scholar and the Schools Division Superintendent to guarantee the implementation of re-entry plan.
  - List of prospective clientele must be submitted with the other documents
5. Selected scholars will be informed through the regional offices.
