TRAINING OF TRAINORS (TOT) AND COACHES, AND TECHNICAL AND CLASSIFICATION SEMINARS FOR THE DIFFERENTLY ABLED PERSONS

To: Bureau Directors
 Regional Directors

 Heads, Public and Private Schools

1. In line with the continuous efforts to develop sports for persons with disabilities, the Philippine Sports Association for the Differently Abled-National Paralympic Committee of the Philippines (PHILSPADA-NPC Philippines) under the auspices and authority of the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) in coordination with the Department of Education (DepEd) through the Task Force on School Sports (TFSS) shall conduct the **Training of Trainors (TOT) and Coaches, and Technical and Classification Seminars for the Differently Abled Persons**. 3. The training-seminar aims to:
 1. create awareness of the sports program of the differently abled in the local/grassroots and in the national level;
 2. organize and train coaches and trainers in the proper system of coaching and training of differently abled athletes;
 3. establish a pool of coaches, trainers, technical officials and classifiers who will help the differently abled athletes in all levels of competitions;
 4. identify the outstanding athletes;
 5. install correct classification for virtually impaired and orthopedically handicapped athletes; and
 6. form a national pool of differently abled athletes, duly recognized by the PHILSPADA-NPC Philippines.
4. These activities will have three (3) components: (1) *Training of the Trainers and Coaches*; (2) *Technical and Classification Seminars*; and (3) *Talent Identification*.
5. The participating athletes for the *Talent Identification* in Athletics, Swimming, Table Tennis, Goalball and Futzal, Boccia are those who are orthopedically handicapped and visually impaired. The training may be used by PHILSPADA-NPC Philippines as basis for the selection of the Philippine team for the upcoming 2013 Youth Paragames, 2012 London Paralympic Games, and 2014 ASEAN Paragames to be held in Incheon, South Korea.
6. The PHILSPADA-NPC Philippines shall provide for the board and lodging, while the participants' transportation and other incidental expenses shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations. Confirmation of attendance shall be made one (1) week before the scheduled training.
