**SCHOOL YEAR 2012-2013 DISTRIBUTION OF GRADE 7 (FIRST YEAR) EDUCATION SERVICE CONTRACTING (ESC) SLOTS UNDER THE GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE TO STUDENTS AND TEACHERS IN PRIVATE EDUCATION (GASTPE) PROGRAM**

Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

1. Based on the needs, given the normal carrying capacities of public secondary schools, the Department of Education (DepEd) through the Office of the Planning Service (OPS) has determined/allocated the School Year (SY) 2012-2013 distribution of Grade 7 (First Year) Education Service Contracting (ESC) slots under the Government Assistance to Students and Teachers in Private Education (GASTPE) Program. This is provided for in DepEd Order No. 35, s. 2012 entitled "Policies and Guidelines on the Implementation of Government Assistance to Students and Teachers in Private Education (GASTPE) Program."
2. The Regional Program Committee (RPCom) shall be responsible for the distribution for Grade 7 (First Year) slots for each GASTPE-participating school on the basis of need and on the school's demonstrated capacity to utilize slots previously allotted to them. The RPCom shall inform the GASTPE-participating schools of their allocations and these shall serve as basis for the filling up of slots.
3. A report on the distribution and utilization of ESC slots shall be forwarded to the Fund for Assistance to Private Education (FAPE), which shall render a report to the DepEd Central Office (CO) through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) on or before **June 30, 2012**.
4. The indicative allocation/distribution of Grade 7 ESC slots by region and by division is contained in Enclosure Nos. 1 and 2, respectively.
5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
