11TH COMPUTER CAMP FOR THE BLIND

To: Bureau Directors

1. The Resources for the Blind, Inc. (RBI), in partnership with the Overbrook Nippon Foundation, Inc. and IBM Philippines, will hold its **11th Computer Camp for the Blind** from October 29, 2012 to November 9, 2012 at the IBM Philippines, IBM Plaza, Eastwood City Cyberpark, Libis, Quezon City.
2. The Activity aims to provide the participants, who are all totally blind, with the training and knowledge they need to enhance their computer skills in preparation for college and/or jobs that need computer skills.
3. The participants to this activity are high school students who will be selected based on the following criteria:
 - a. Must be 3rd or 4th year high school;
 - b. Must be totally blind or severe low vision;
 - c. Must be familiar with the keyboard keys or background in computer;
 - d. Must not have participated in previous computer-eyes training;
 - e. Must be willing and able to travel alone to and from Manila; and
 - f. Must be willing to share to other blind the knowledge he gained from the training.
