**FIRST PHASE OF THE TEACHERS' SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE GRADUATE
DIPLOMA IN CULTURAL EDUCATION IN SUMMER 2013**

1. The National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), in cooperation with the Department of Education (DepEd), announces the **First Phase of the Teachers' Scholarship for the Graduate Diploma in Cultural Education in Summer 2013**, a post-baccalaureate in-service teacher enhancement program in the following Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) and cities/provinces:

2. The Scholarship Program aims to:

- a. expand the teacher-scholars' knowledge-based in Philippine history, culture, heritage and the arts and their application to culture-based teaching of basic education;
- b. provide them with hands-on opportunities for critical dialogue with the local culture and arts practitioners;
- c. help them develop knowledge structures, framework and information systems which integrate history, culture, heritage and the arts into the formal basic education curriculum; and
- d. build their capability to contribute to a deeper understanding of the local history, culture, heritage and the arts in the context of contemporary Philippine realities.

3. The 24 unit graduate credit program follows a two-summer ladderized curriculum designed for public school teachers of any subject area at the elementary and high school levels. The first phase consisting of 12 graduate-level academic credits will start in Summer 2013. Level I scholars are expected to continue on to Level II to be offered in Summer 2014. Successful graduates of this two-summer program have the option to continue the Master of Education, Major in Cultural Education to be offered in HEIs selected by NCCA.

4. The NCCA shall provide the scholarship grant consisting of full tuition and registration, workshop kits and materials, and a Five Thousand Pesos (P 5,000.00) stipend to subsidize meals, accommodations and other sundry expenses. The transportation of teacher-scholars to and from the venue may be charged to local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations or may be sourced from other funds.

5. Inquiries may be addressed to the HEIs nearest to the applicants' place with the contact details provided for in the program information. The deadline for submission of nominations and/or applications is on **March 11, 2013** and successful applicants shall be notified on or before **March 29, 2013**. The implementing HEIs shall act on nominations and applications on a *first-received, first-to-be-processed* basis and may issue admission notice even before the deadline for application if they find that the nominee or applicant is deserving of the scholarship grant. Class sessions will start on **April 15, 2013**, or on a date to be fixed by the HEI.

6. This is the third batch of the Teachers' Scholarship Graduate Diploma in Cultural Education conducted by NCCA. Phase II of the 2012 Batch of Teachers' Scholars for Graduate Certificate in Cultural Education will continue this summer 2013.

2013 Graduate Diploma in Cultural Education
Program Information

Description and Objectives

The program is a two-summer 24-unit post-baccalaureate program divided into Graduate Diploma in Cultural Education Levels I and II. It offers foundation and major courses to enhance the students' understanding of the basic theories, processes and applications of arts, culture, heritage in the culture-based teaching of the basic education curriculum.

Following are its objectives:

1. To expand the teacher-participants' knowledge base in Philippine history, culture, heritage and the arts;
2. To provide the teacher-participants with hands-on opportunities for critical dialogue with the local culture and arts;
3. To help the teacher-participants develop knowledge structures, framework and information systems that integrate history, culture, heritage and the arts into the formal curriculum of basic education; and
4. To build the teacher-participants' capability to contribute to a deeper understanding and appreciation of the local history, culture, heritage and the arts in the context of contemporary Philippine realities .

Students shall undergo the following ladder-type curriculum:

Diploma Program Level 1 (Summer 2013)

CulEd 201 – Pedagogy of Cultural Education

CulEd 202 – Cultural Diversity and Languages of the Philippines

CulEd 203 – Re-view of Philippine History and Heritage

CulEd 204 – Philippine Arts

Diploma Program Level II (Summer 2014)

CulEd 205 – Local Cultural Mapping

CulEd 206 – Media-Based Cultural Documentation

CulEd 207 – Issues in Cultural Education

CulEd 208 – Development of Culture-Based Lesson Exemplars

Graduates of the 24-unit diploma program may pursue the Master of Education (MAEd) Major in Cultural Education or Master in Cultural Education program, on scholarship basis, to be offered by Higher Education Institutions selected by the NCCA

Scholarship Eligibilities and Provisions

Target participants are basic education public school teachers of any subject-area who meet the following eligibility requirements:

1. 23 – 50 years old with good moral character;
2. Bachelor degree holder with general weighted average of 85% or equivalent;
3. With at least three (3) years of teaching experience with permanent appointment in any or a combination of academic subjects in a public elementary or high school;
4. LET-passer; and
5. Endorsed by the principal, district supervisor; division education supervisor or division superintendent (any one of the above).

Interested participants should submit the following documentation requirements:

1. Duly accomplished nomination form signed by recognized authority
2. Duly accomplished application form signed by the teacher-applicant;
3. NSO-certified birth certificate or copy of passport page showing citizenship and age;
4. Certified true copy of LET results or certification; and
5. Certified true copy of collegiate transcript of records; and
6. Endorsement and certification letter from any recognized authority (see above)

The NCCA shall provide scholarship subsidy consisting of full tuition and registration, workshop kits and materials, and a Php 5,000 stipend to partially cover meals, accommodations and other sundry expenses. Transportation to and from the venue shall be the participants' responsibility which may be charged to local funds.
