DECLARING MONDAY, 13 MAY 2013, AS A SPECIAL PUBLIC (NON-  
WORKING) HOLIDAY THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY

**WHEREAS**, the national and local elections shall be held on Monday, 13 May 2013;


**WHEREAS**, Monday, 13 May 2013 should be declared a special public (non-working) holiday to enable the people to properly exercise their right of suffrage.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, BENIGNO S. AQUINO, III**, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law do hereby declare Monday, 13 May 2013, as a special public (non-working) holiday throughout the country.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of April, in the year of Our Lord, Two Thousand and Thirteen.
