1. The Bureau of Elementary Education-Department of Education (BEE-DepEd) in cooperation with the National Association of Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of Elementary Education (NACACEE) will hold its **59<sup>th</sup> National Conference** with the theme *The NACACEE: Strengthening Its Role in the Attainment of EFA 2015 Through the Enhanced K to 12 Basic Education Program* on June 24-28, 2013 at the El Pescador Resort Hotel, Bolinao, Pangasinan with Region I as the host region.

2. The Conference aims to:

- a. enhance knowledge and understanding of the participants on elementary programs and projects in terms of achievement vis-a-vis Education for All (EFA) goals and targets;
- b. orient them on the proposed multi-literacy and numeracy programs;
- c. deepen their understanding on the ASEAN curriculum; and
- d. update them on the DepEd Rationalization Program: its rationale and Change Management Team (CMT) milestones.

3. The participants to this activity are the Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of Elementary Education Division (EED) in the 17 regions and the BEE, Directors III and IV, and selected Senior Education Program Specialists (SEPS) from BEE.
