



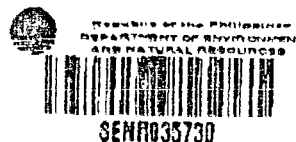
SUBJECT : *Institutionalization of Priority Lanes for Senior
