20TH ANNUAL POSTER-MAKING CONTEST OF THE CITIZEN'S DISASTER
RESPONSE CENTER

The Citizen's Disaster Response Center (CDRC) will conduct its *20th Annual Poster-Making Contest* entitled *Apoy, Bagyo, Kalamidad: Dibuhong Pambata (ABKD)*.

The Competition aims to generate children's perspective on disaster preparedness through artworks.

The Contest will be conducted in two categories with its respective themes, as follows:

Category A (7-9 years old)	Category B (10-12 years old)

The contestants will think of ways on how they can help their respective communities prepare for disasters by expressing their ideas in a poster and choose from the abovementioned themes according to their age category.

The design of the poster should be drawn using any medium of their choice on a ¼ (20"x15") illustration board. Entries should include titles and captions and should be covered with plastic when submitted. Contestants should indicate the category and theme of choice on their entries.

The deadline for submission of entries is on *September 16, 2016*.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption of classes* policy stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
