Tempest Reimagined	A Filipino adaption of Shakespeare's classic. Three cultures come together to tell a story of a fantastic storm that brings drastic change in an island and the lives of its dwellers. <b>Tempest Re-Imagined, weaves the stories of Yolanda survivors with the magic of Shakespeare's original text, creating a universal narrative with a Filipino heart.</b> The play tackles themes on disasters and how they affect the lives of victims and survivors. Caredivas	Caregivers by day, performers by night-- <b>five transgender overseas Filipino workers in Israel struggle to make ends meet, and find freedom and acceptance in a foreign land.</b> Caredivas returns on February 2017 to kick start PETA's 50 <sup>th</sup> season program.	February-March 2017

These performances aim to expose learners to Culture and the Arts.

The students and teachers from both public and private schools are invited to watch the plays.
