#### APPLICATION FOR THE FUTURE ACHIEVERS INTERNATIONAL PROGRAM FOR 2016

The *Future Achievers International (FAI) Program* is a spin-off from the Canadian Future Achievers (CFA) Program which recognizes and provides financial awards to academically strong and community-involved youth.

The Program aims to provide positive reinforcement for Future Achievers and to encourage them to maintain high expectations for themselves, complete high school and master their post-secondary studies.

The nominations for the FAI Programscholarship is now open to students who:

1. are between nine to 16 years of age;
2. have a minimum academic average of "A";
3. have demonstrated commitment to and engagement in extracurricular activities; and
4. are recognized by his/her teachers as being capable of acting as a role model among peers.

Interested applicants may send the following requirements on or before *November 14, 2016* to the International Cooperation Office (ICO), Ground Floor, Teodora Alonso Building, Department of Education (DepEd) Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City:

1. Duly accomplished Application Form

4. Recommendation letter from the School Principal stating reasons why the student is identified as a role model; and
5. Statement by the student as to why he/she wishes to be a member of FAI.
