The Philippine Federation of Chemistry Societies (PFCS) Inc. will hold its *7<sup>th</sup> National Children's On-the-Spot Chemistry Poster-Making Competition* with the theme *Chemistry for Peaceful Use* on *February 18, 2017* in 12 different venues nationwide.

The Competition aims to:

1. contribute to a greater public interest and appreciation of Chemistry particularly among the youth;
2. recognize learners with inherent artistic talents; and

The two main activities during the event are the following:
