The Philippine Stagers Foundation (PSF), on its 16th Season, announces the staging of the following *Plays and Musicals for School Year 2017-2018* in various theater venues in Metro Manila and selected provinces:

Title	Description
<i>Obra ni Juan, The Musical</i>	This musical presentation is about the life of Filipino painter and sculptor Juan Luna as well as the struggles of other Filipino heroes like Antonio Luna and Jose Rizal during the Spanish Colonial rule.
<i>Bonifacio, Isang Sarswela</i>	The 2012 KBP Golden Dove Awardee is a musical presentation about the life of Andres Bonifacio.
<i>Katips, Ang mga Bagong Katipunero</i>	The 2016 <i>Aliw</i> Awardee and Broadway World Awardee for the Best Musical Presentation of the Year, is about Martial Law.
4C-7 (Four Contemporary Plays on its Seventh Season)	This is a collection of all original one-act plays.

The Stage Plays and Musicals aim to:

1. teach the students about the value of life, freedom, human rights, and democracy;
2. impart to their audience the value of heroism and the struggles of the nation during Martial Law;
3. teach the importance of family, friendship, and love of country;
4. promote Filipino values, culture, and the arts; and
5. teach mastery of the Filipino Language and Literature through the lines and dialogues using the vernacular of the present times.

The learners and teachers from both public and private secondary schools are invited to watch the plays and musicals.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*. This is also subject to the no-collection policy as stated in Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546, *An Act Prohibiting the Sale of Tickets and/or the Collection of Contributions for Whatever Project or Purpose from Students and Teachers of Public and Private Schools, Colleges, and Universities (Ganzon Law)*.
