2017 MTAP-DEPED SATURDAY PROGRAMS IN MATHEMATICS FOR REGULAR  
AND TALENTED LEARNERS OF THE MATHEMATICS TEACHERS  
ASSOCIATION OF THE PHILIPPINES INC.

The Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines (MTAP) Inc. will be offering the *2017 MTAP-DepEd Saturday Programs in Mathematics for Regular and Talented Learners*.

The first program is intended for regular learners. This will be conducted on six Saturdays, 8:00 a.m.-12:00 noon, from July 22 to August 26, 2017. The sessions will be for learners who belong from the 25th to the 85th percentile at each grade level from Grades 1 to 11. A center may opt to take participants only for Grade 4 because of the Mother Tongue policy. A written permit from the parents is necessary.

The first Program aims to:

1. provide the learners with the opportunity to explore Mathematics without the threat of tests;
2. review the materials covered last school year to enable them to do well in Mathematics in the present school year; and
3. prepare the Grades 6 and 10 learners for entrance examinations for Grade 7, Junior High School (JHS), and Grade 11, Senior High School (SHS).

The second program is for mathematically talented learners. This will be conducted on seven Saturdays, 8:00 a.m.-12:00 noon, from *October 28 to December 9, 2017*. The sessions will be for learners who belong to the top 15th percentile. The school principal shall endorse the learners who wish to participate, along with a written permit from their parents/guardians.

The second Program aims to:

1. prepare the Grades 6 and 10 learners for entrance examinations for Grade 7, JHS, and Grade 11, SHS; and
2. prepare them for the Metrobank MTAP-DepEd Math Challenge Competition.
