**NATIONAL CONSULTATIVE CONFERENCE OF PRESIDENTS

1. The Department of Education–Bureau of Learning Delivery (DepEd–BLD), through the Student Inclusion Division (SID), will conduct the **National Consultative Conference of Presidents or Principals of Participating Private Madaris** from September 19 to 22, 2017 in Cebu City.
2. The activity aims to
  - a. provide policy direction in the implementation of financial assistance to private madaris;
  - b. clarify or address issues and concerns on the implementation of financial assistance; and
  - c. appraise the necessary documents required for participating in the financial assistance program.
3. The participants are preferably the president or principal of the Private Madaris as indicated in Enclosure No. 1. Only one representative from each of the Private Madaris shall be allowed to attend the said activity.
4. Traveling expenses of participants going to and from the venue shall be charged to local funds, while traveling expenses, board and lodging of DepEd management team and participants shall be charged to the project funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. The concerned regional office through the Regional Arabic Language and Islamic Values Education (ALIVE) Coordinator is requested to inform and provide assistance to the Private Madaris in the preparation of documents to be inspected and verified by DepEd Central Office Team of Evaluators.
6. Confirmation of attendance shall be done by accomplishing the confirmation sheet provided in Enclosure No. 2 and send it to the Bureau of Learning Delivery–Student Inclusion Division (BLD–SID) on or before **September 8, 2017**. Participants in this activity are advised to bring the necessary documents or requirements for appraisal as listed in Enclosure No. 3.

3. Original/certified true copy/authenticated copy of Government Permit/Government Recognition.
4. Certified copy of Deed of Donation or Certificate Title for Madrasah Site
5. Report on the utilization of financial assistance for SY 2015-2016, 2016-2017, with supporting evidences such as original official receipt, payroll duly signed by teacher recipients.
6. School ID Number
7. School Forms 1 and 6 signed by the principal/school head
8. Certification signed by the academic head and the president of the private madaris stating that the old curriculum of madrasah shall be gradually phased out
9. Board Resolution adopting the K-12 curriculum
10. Official statement signed by the Academic Head or Registrar AND the President of the madrasah stating that the tuition fee collected is not less than P 5,000.00 per student/school year
11. Schedule of tuition and other fees signed by the school registrar and approved by the school head
12. Updated list of K-12 Teachers teaching secular subjects. The teachers' transcript of record (TOR), LET Result and photocopy of updated Teacher's License, Service Record and Contract should be submitted
13. Updated list of Teachers teaching religious subject (ISAL), including the updated profile (TOR, Diploma, Service Record, Contract)
14. Matrix of Teacher's Program (K-12 and ISAL)
15. Number of learners enrolled per Grade Level and per Section/s, certified by the registrar and school head
16. Student Individual Record per Grade Level and per Section/s, certified by the registrar and school head. The LRN of students must be indicated
17. Copy of the curriculum for K-12 and ISAL subjects.
