The National University of Educational Planning and Administration (NUEPA), New Delhi, India announces the offering of the **28th International Diploma Course in Educational Planning and Administration (IDEPA)**. The course will run in the following two (2) phases:

Phase II	Research Project in the Philippines	May 1 - July 31, 2012	

The course aims to augment the capabilities and competencies of the target clientele in the aspect of planning and administration.

The NUEPA invites education policy-makers, planners and administrators in the Philippines to participate in this program.

The Government of India provides financial assistance under various schemes like the Indian Technical and Economic Cooperation (ITEC), the Special Commonwealth Assistance for Africa Programme (SCAAP) and the Colombo Plan.

Interested applicants may also seek funding assistance from other international agencies/organizations like United Nations Development Program (UNDP), United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), World Bank (WB), Swedish International Development Agency (SIDA), Asian Development Bank (ADB), Danish International Development Assistance (DANIDA) and the British Council (BC).

Only forty (40) seats are allotted based on a specified selection criterion; hence, nominations should be forwarded to NUEPA not later than **December 9, 2011**. Funding sources should be clearly indicated in the application form.
