**4<sup>TH</sup> BAGASBAS BEACH INTERNATIONAL ECO-ARTS FESTIVAL (BBIEAF)**

The Our Lady of Lourdes College Foundation will hold the **4<sup>th</sup> Bagasbas Beach International Eco-Arts Festival (BBIEAF)** with the theme "*Degrees*" from February 27 to March 4, 2012 in Daet, Camarines Norte. The BBIEAF is a showcase of the meeting of the community and the artists and a festival which looks to the product of this interaction and impresses the equal importance of community participation in the artistic process. The ills of pollution, declining biodiversity and wasteful management of resources takes center stage in this festival.

This activity aims to:

1. allow the participants to view at a form of creativity which they can use to manage their everyday lives and to create solutions to their problems;
2. give the vast number of the disadvantaged fellow Filipinos the experience of Art as a tool for development; and
