2ND PHILIPPINE GEOGRAPHY OLYMPIAD

The Geographic Society of the University of the Philippines (GSUP) will hold the **2nd Philippine Geography Olympiad** on December 3, 2011 at the National Institute of Science and Mathematics Education (NISMED) Auditorium, UP Diliman, Quezon City.

The competition aims to:

1. promote the discipline of Geography among high school students;
2. introduce Geography as a discipline which deals with the study of earth as one home, and a possible career path where students are taught skills in analyzing geographic patterns observed on the earth's surface, as well as understanding human-environment interactions; and
3. provide a venue for high school Geography enthusiasts to share their knowledge and interests in Geography.

This contest is open to all secondary schools in the Philippines whether public or private. A school can only send one (1) team. The schools which wish to participate must properly and completely accomplish the Registration Form.

Each participating team shall be charged a registration fee of One Hundred Pesos (PhP100.00) on December 3, 2011 before the conduct of the Quiz Bee.

The participating team shall be composed of two (2) regular contestants, one (1) alternate contestant and a coach. The contestant and alternate must be enrolled as third year students in the school which they represent.
