**6<sup>TH</sup> NATIONAL TRAINING-WORKSHOP ON BUILDING AND SUSTAINING  
A VIBRANT SCHOOL CULTURE  
(Principles, Issues and Challenges Related to School Improvement)**

The School of Education and Human Development (SED) of the University of Asia and the Pacific (UA&P) will conduct the **6<sup>th</sup> National Training-Workshop on Building and Sustaining a Vibrant School Culture (Principles, Issues and Challenges Related to School Improvement)** on April 25-27, 2012 at the PHELA Grande Hotel, General Santos City.

The Training-Workshop aims to:

1. self-audit and describe the culture of the participants' respective schools;
2. grasp a deeper understanding of school culture, its components, and the forces which shape it;
3. assess the operational implications of their self-audit and force-field analysis on the culture of their respective schools; and
4. draw up action measures (for improving the present culture of their respective schools) which focus on the key aspects or elements of school culture within their control.

The target participants to this activity are the newly confirmed principals, experienced school principals and administrators, and teacher-leaders from both public and private schools.

Each participant will be charged a registration fee of Four Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (PhP4,800.00) inclusive of workshop materials, compact discs, conference bags, certificates, accommodations and meals (3), and a.m. and p.m. snacks (6). The participants are encouraged to confirm their attendance on or before **April 6, 2012**. Participants who will notify the Secretariat regarding their flight schedule will be accommodated for a shuttle service from General Santos City Airport to the venue on a first-come, first-served basis.
