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TRAINING AND SEMINAR OF HOME ECONOMICS AND TECHNOLOGY TEACHERS'
ORGANIZATION OF THE PHILIPPINES

The Home Economics and Technology Teachers' Organization of the Philippines (HETTOP) Inc., in partnership with the Cebu Technological University Main Campus, will conduct a training and seminar with the theme Revitalize Skill Competencies in Home Economics and Technology for Millennium Work Force from September 20 to 22, 2018 at the Cebu Business Hotel, Cebu City.

The training and seminar aims to:

1. intensify dissemination of knowledge and skills on the competencies offered in the following areas of Technology and Livelihood Education:
 - a. home economics,
 - b. industrial arts,
 - c. agriculture and fishery arts, and
 - d. information computer technology.
2. provide program of activities that will enrich Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE)/*Edukasyong Pantahanan at Pangkabuhayan* (EPP) teachers with experiences in home economics and technology in support to the aims of the K to 12 Program to make efficient on its implementation; and
