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#### I. CALL TO ORDER

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Asec. Revsee A. Escobedo, BAC II Chairperson, presided and called the prebid conference to order at 1:18 P.M. The BAC Secretariat documented the minutes of meeting.

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#### CERTIFICATION OF QUORUM II.

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The BAC II Chairperson certified that the quorum of the BAC was present to transact business. He acknowledged the presence of the BAC members, BAC

Secretariat, Technical Working Group, and end-user representative, and made a roll call of the prospective bidders in the attendance registry.

## III. HIGHLIGHTS OF DISCUSSION

The BAC II Chairperson welcomed everyone to the pre-bid conference.

Dir. Robert M. Agustin, BAC II Vice-Chairperson, asked for the origin of the prospective bidders. Mr. Albert P. Escobar (Ayana Construction and Trading) stated that their office is in Nueva Ecija; Mr. Rommel Nucup (Nulas Builders) and Mr. Tracy M. Tupe (Traccor Builders) stated that they are both from Pampanga, and the latter is the current contractor of the Gabaldon buildings; Mr. Jhester Vanz Barbaso (Soy Eng Construction) is located in Zamboanga del Norte with a satellite office in Quezon City; and Ms. Shiela Nina B. Saballero (Golden 3T Construction Corp.) is from Caloocan City and currently, the contractor of the repair of various buildings in DepEd Central Office.

Ms. Lady Love S. Arenas gave a brief description of the project at hand. She added that invitations were sent to the Commission on Audit (COA), Resident Ombudsman and various civil society organizations (CSOs) thru letters dated July 27, 2018. She also reported that no bidder purchased Bidding Documents to date.

Atty. Cornelio Pacala inquired on the manner of sending the invitations. He also asked whether follow-up on the invitations sent was done and if there were proofs of receipt and acknowledgement. Ms. Buela responded that invitations to various CSOs were sent via email. ANSA-EAP acknowledged the invitation, while the letter to COA was physically received. No follow-up has been made.

The BAC II Chairperson clarified that Section 13.3 of RA 9184 only directs that observers shall be sent an invitation in writing at least five (5) calendar days before the date of the procurement activity, and the BAC Secretariat satisfied the requirement. Furthermore, he added that the absence of observers will not nullify the BAC proceedings.

Mr. Tupe clarified on the eligibility of the bidder in relation to the definition of similar experience and contracts. The BAC II Chairperson responded that the Single Largest Completed Contract is essential in the determination of the eligibility of the bidder as described on the reference to similar contracts: Repair, Rehabilitation and/or Restoration of Buildings.

Ms. Saballero asked whether the organizational charts showing the list of personnel would be per building or per lot. Arch. Cesar Andrew Alaban stated that the organizational chart will be on a per building as presented in BDS, ITB Clause 12.1 (b)(ii.2).

Mr. Tupe appealed that changes be made on the huge requirement of key personnel per building, i.e., site/construction supervisor (architect, engineer), safety officer and general foreman. He stated that if the works will be done simultaneously, lesser key personnel may be accommodated into the number of buildings indicated per lot. He reasoned that for a one hundred million (100,000,000) project, a procuring entity may only require one or two (1-2) engineers. Arch. Alaban stated that the required personnel is on a per building basis and the use of the same name of a person in numerous organizational chart is not allowed.

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Mr. Tupe followed through with the readiness of BTC to accommodate the number of workers on site. The BAC II Vice-Chairperson responded that BTC has a vast space and will require enough workers to supervise the project. For consideration, the BAC II Chairperson noted on the observation raised. He advised that the concern will be discussed with the TWG and a bid bulletin will be issued if needed.

Ms. Saballero asked whether the sample and brochure/s can be submitted during post qualification and not during the submission of bids. The BAC II Chairperson responded that submission of sample and brochure/s during bid opening may be submitted at the bidder's option, otherwise, it is a requirement during post-qualification.

Ms. Saballero raised the issue of temporary PCAB license. She asked if the BAC will accept the same. Ms. Saballero and Mr. Tupe explained that temporary PCAB license is issued pending verification by the board during renewal period. The BAC II Chairperson noted the concern for further discussion with the TWG.

Ms. Saballero asked if site inspection is required before buying the bid documents. The BAC II Chairperson responded that site inspection is not an integral part of the process of procurement activity for this project. At the prospective bidder's option, they can exercise due diligence before buying the bidding documents. The BAC provided the name and contact information of Arch. Alaban as the focal person in BTC, in case of site inspection. The BAC II Chairperson reminded on the "No Contact Rule" after the deadline of submission of bids.

The BAC reminded the prospective bidders to write a clarification letter which may be sent via the BAC Secretariat e-mail address on or before August 3, 2018, 5:00 P.M.

Having no other matters to discuss, the pre-bid conference was adjourned at 2:22 P.M.
