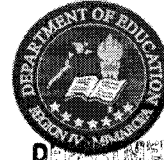

SUBJECT : **REGIONAL ORIENTATION-WORKSHOP ON ORTHOGRAPHY  
DEVELOPMENT FOR INDIGENOUS PEOPLES LANGUAGES**

1. In Line with the National Indigenous Peoples Education Policy Framework (DepEd Order No. 62, s. 2011 and DepEd Order No. 51, s.2014, ILO Convention No. 169 Article 6 (1, 2)) particularly the policy thrust to *Implement stronger affirmative action to eradicate all forms of discrimination against indigenous peoples (IPs) in the entire Philippine education system, uphold and advocate the protection of the intellectual property rights of IPs and ensure the Consultation and participation being the fundamental principles of democratic governance and of inclusive development*, DepEd MIMAROPA Region will conduct a **Five-Day Regional Orientation Workshop on Orthography Development for Indigenous Peoples Languages originally proposed to be held on January 22-27, 2017 will be moved to January 30-February 03, 2017 at Westfields Residences, Eurotel, Pedro Gil, Malate, Metro Manila.**

2. The training-workshop aims to orient the participants on the principles of orthography development, the importance of developing orthography, and sociolinguistic issues and concerns. The orthographies of the different indigenous peoples (IP) languages will be the basis for developing teaching materials and assessment in the mother tongue of the learners.


