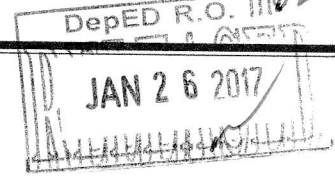

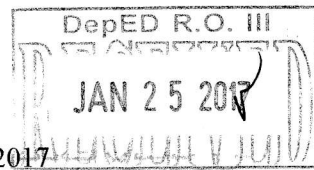

Dr. Walsh finished his Doctor of Philosophy degree from the University of Tasmania where he undertook a research in the area of Teacher Appraisal and Teacher Standards. He obtained his Master of Education degree from the University of New England, the focus of which is Curriculum Studies in Science. Dr. Walsh obtained his Bachelor of Education degree from the University of South Africa. He has also a Tasmanian Teacher Certificate from the Department of Education, a Diploma of Education from the University of Tasmania and a Bachelor of Science degree also from the same university.

Dr. William Atweh (Australia)

Dr. William Atweh is an adjunct professor of the Science and Mathematics Education Center at the Curtin University, in Perth Australia. He is also an adjunct professor at Queensland University of Technology, Queensland Australia and a Professor Extraordinary at the University of South Africa. He is currently a visiting professor at the Philippine Normal University in Manila and an international education consultant in the Philippines and in various countries.

Registration Fee:



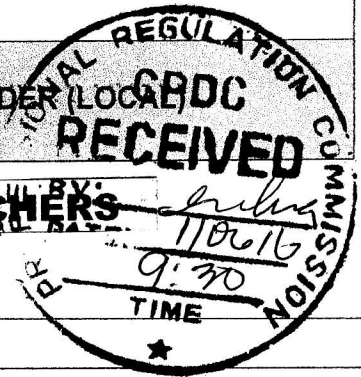
