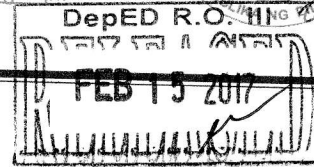

The showing of the Film aims to:

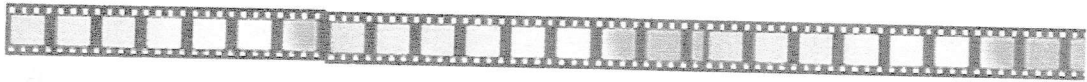
1. show the importance of pursuing education and increase awareness among students on the relevant issues tackled in the film (i.e. finishing school and bullying);

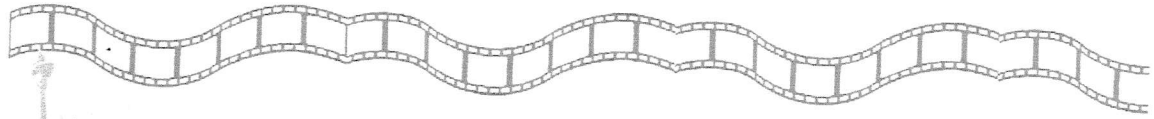

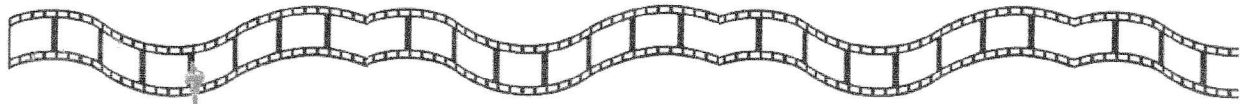
friends and dealing with the pressures of school.

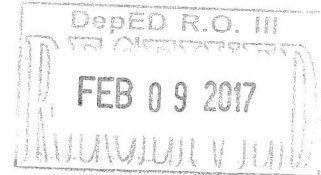
