REDESIGNING EDUCATION: GROWING HEALTHY LIFE OF PEACE EDUCATION

The Cahbriba Alternative School Foundation (CASF) hereby presents the results of the consultations undertaken with the DepEd's Assistant Secretaries on the conceptual framework of the proposed mainstreaming of the innovative learning system on **Growing Healthy Life of Peace Education**.

"Education for All (EFA) is a global call for societies and local communities to participate in managing the change initiatives and sustaining the momentum of transformation of organizations. EFA challenges all institutions (schools, family, neighborhood, civil, business, church and government) to reclaim the community capacity and responsibility as engaging citizenship for growing inclusive HEALTHY Learning Institutions of Family Education (LIFE).

It is about education as a community function in developing the learning capabilities, competencies of the global village and the motivation to aspire for the sustainable identification and participation of the children and youth. People engaged in active community experience of education becomes the contextual learning structure of LIFE that unites and nurtures the promotion, productivity and protection of community stakeholders.

The Healthy Life of Peace Education is a consistent developmental asset framework of a Learning Community Environment which leverages the investment strategies of a Transformational Alternative Life Learning (TALL) System Order of CIDSS of Peace. Previous Memorandum of Agreements (1995-2004) with DepEd and DSWD will scaffold into the current change initiatives of the Department of Education. The growth processes and procedures in the TALL system of Change is inclusive... seamless, an intergenerational family supported social network and aligned to the Philippine Education of the Millennium Development Goals within a local setting.

The investment in change innovations has four core essential goals in growing Healthy Life of Peace Education as follows: 1) activating a community's asset building power; 2) building social connections across Learning Institutions on Family Empowerment (LIFE); 3) unleashing the Human Development Power of Learning; and 4) bridging leadership of CIDSS between the Council of Peace in seven (7) towns of Laguna and Regions IV, V and XII (Sarangani) as a coalition base of the National Life of Peace Education. This is a 3-phased program action plan for exploratory discussion".

The Memorandum of Agreement between the DepEd and the Cahbriba Alternative School Foundation is under study and approval.
