7TH NATIONAL YOUTH CONGRESS (NYC)

The National Youth Congress (NYC) Organizing Body, a partnership between the leading student organizations in the University of the Philippines (UP), Diliman – the U.P. Economics Society (UP EcoSoc) and the UP School of Economics Council (UP SESC) will hold its **7th National Youth Congress (NYC)** with the theme “*The Green Light Projects: Moving Markets Towards Environmental Sustainability*”. This activity is scheduled on August 27-28, 2010 at the Diosdado Macapagal Hall, School of Economics, UP Diliman, Quezon City.

The congress aims to:

- a. show the power of economic thinking in clarifying questions on the present environmental issues such as resource management and conservation and the like;
- b. give high school students an engaging introduction to the field of economics; and
- c. serve as an avenue towards a deepened understanding of economics via a theoretical perspective and the subsequent application of economic theory to real-world problems.

The students from the top public and private secondary schools are invited to participate to this activity.

Each participant from public schools will be charged a discounted registration fee while each participant from private schools is required to pay a minimal registration fee. Registration fee will cover expenses for snacks, lunch, cocktail dinner and NYC kits and academic materials.
