**NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON THE 5<sup>TH</sup> FOOD INDUSTRY SANITATION  
AND URBAN PEST AND AGRO-MANAGEMENT**

In celebration of the 14<sup>th</sup> National Urban Pest Control Week per Presidential Proclamation Nos. 990/2063 with the theme, "*Producing Foods and Clean Energy in Waste and Pest-Free Facilities, Cities and Farms*" on September 20-26, 2010, the National Committee on Urban Pest Control (NCUPC) will hold the national conference entitled "**5<sup>th</sup> Food Industry Sanitation and Urban Pest and Agro-Management**" on September 24, 2010 at the CAP Development & Convention Center, CAP Building, Anda Street, Davao City.

The objectives of the conference are to provide prospective participants with:

- a. sanitation/green management procedures in farms and food processing facilities;
- b. information necessary to meet government and industry regulations; and
- c. information on urban pest control/green products that are local.

The participants to this activity are the following:

- a. owners, managers, administrators, quality assurance (QA) officers, sanitation, safety and pollution officers of food, banana export manufacturing, processing facilities, soft-drinks, water industries, fast-food chains, restaurants, supermarkets, shopping centers and malls, hotels, motels, inns, and related establishments including establishments that use fuels for boilers in processing;
- b. officials and staff of National Government Agencies (NGAs), Local Government Units (LGUs), Non-Government Organizations (NGOs), and Peoples Organizations who are concerned on food safety, sanitation, quality control, and urban pest management;
- c. private and public institutions, universities including students taking up Food Science, Technology, Housekeeping, Hotel and Restaurant Management (HRM), HRIM, culinary, etc.;
- d. owners, managers, staff of organic banana, sugar plantations; and
- e. medical officers, entomologists, medical entomologists, epidemiologists, sanitarians, environmentalists, and private, public solid waste management workers and practitioners.

A registration fee of Two Thousand Pesos (Php2,000.00) will be charged each participant inclusive of two (2) snacks, lunch, conference kit, and certificates. Prospective participants from government offices can avail of the privilege discounts. Early registrants shall receive ten percent (10%) discount per head.
