**SEMINAR ON INCLUSION: DISSOLVING THE BOUNDARIES  
FOR CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS**

The School of Education and Human Development (SED) of the University of Asia and the Pacific (UA&P) will hold a one (1)-day seminar entitled, "*Inclusion: Dissolving the Boundaries for Children with Special Needs*" on January 29, 2011 from 8:30 am to 5:30 pm at the PLDT Hall, APEC Communications Building, UA&P, Pearl Drive, Ortigas Center, Pasig City.

The seminar brings to reality the combined expertise of educators who have taken inclusion as one of their advocacies in helping and teaching children with special needs and their families. The program will not only provide the participants with a working knowledge on the concept of inclusion but also with the idea that inclusion is all about belonging and participating in a diverse society.

A conference fee of Two Thousand Five Pesos (PhP2,500.00) will be charged each participant inclusive of two (2) snacks, lunch, conference kit and a certificate of participation.
