**ADVANCED COURSE ON MANAGEMENT AND RE/HABILITATION
OF HEARING IMPAIRED CHILDREN**

In line with the celebration of the Deaf Awareness Week on the second week of November, the Philippine Academy of Neuro-otology, Otology and Related Sciences (PANORS), National Institutes of Health - Philippine National Ear Institute, St. Francis School and the University of Santo Tomas (UST) will conduct an eight-day **Advanced Course on Management and Re/Habilitation of Hearing Impaired Children** on October 22-29, 2010.

The course aims to:

- a. enhance Special Education (SPED) teachers' and other support professionals' knowledge and skills in managing children with hearing impairment;
- b. incorporate medically inclined information with re/habilitation skills; and
- c. provide an overview of the program.

This advanced course is open to SPED teachers.
