### **DISASTER RESPONSE AND PREPAREDNESS TRAINING**

The Center for Emergency Aid and Rehabilitation (CONCERN), Inc. in partnership with the Action and Solidarity for the Empowerment of Teachers (ASSERT) will hold the **Disaster Response and Preparedness Training** on September 22-23, 2010 at the Conference Hall, Marikina Public Market, Marikina City.

The objectives of the training are to:

- a. understand the orientation and principles of Disaster Response Management (DRM) work;
- b. relate the DRM relevance to the Philippine context;
- c. identify risks through hazard mapping and Capacities and Vulnerabilities Assessment (CVA) analysis;
- d. form Grassroots Disaster Response Machineries (GDRMs); and
- e. come-up with a disaster response plan.

The participants to this activity are officers of the faculty clubs/associations and/or their representatives who will be responsible in the re-echoing of the training to their members in the schools specifically those from the divisions of Marikina City, Malabon City, Pasig City, Pateros, Quezon City, Pasay City and Marilao, Bulacan.

A registration fee of Five Hundred Pesos (PhP500.00) will be charged each participant to cover food, kits, certificates and other administrative costs of the training.
