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**MAKE-IT, TAKE-IT WORKSHOP: SOLVING PROBLEMS IN MATHEMATICS
FOR GRADES I AND II TEACHERS**

The Action and Solidarity for the Empowerment of Teachers (ASSERT) will conduct the **Make-It, Take-It Workshop: Solving Problems in Mathematics for Grades I and II Teachers** on October 20-22, 2010 at the *Balay Kalinaw*, University of the Philippines (UP) Campus, Diliman, Quezon City.

The workshop aims to:

- a. allow the participants to share teaching strategies for helping children solve word problems using a second language;
- b. enable them to learn teaching strategies not only from the facilitator but also from co-participants;
- c. show videos of children solving word problems; and
