

DepEd ADVISORY No. 354, s. 2010
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2010 VOCATIONAL EDUCATORS CONGRESS

The Philippine Association for Vocational Education (PAVE), Inc., in cooperation with the Department of Education (DepEd), Philippine Association of State Universities and Colleges (PASUC), Technical Education Skills Development Authority (TESDA), and the Technical-Vocational Education Task Force (TVETF) will hold the **2010 Vocational Educators Congress** with the theme, “*Community-Driven Development Initiatives – for STVEP Sustainability*” on November 18-20, 2010 at the Regional Educational Learning Center (RELC), Region X and other government-owned or controlled venues in the same region.

The congress aims to:

- a. place considerable emphasis on tech-voc schools to create an ideal industrial-environment within the academic institution;
- b. identify strengths and development areas of schools and communities for establishing strong linkages with local industries;
- c. define new directions and goals in pursuit of excellence by their respective school’s line of expertise; and
- d. formulate strategies of collaboration among stakeholders for a doable School Improvement Plan (SIP).

The participants to this activity are as follows:

- a. university/college presidents;
- b. schools division/city superintendents (SDSs) and/or assistant schools division/city superintendents (ASDSs) in-charge of secondary education with tech-voc high schools;
- c. chiefs, secondary education divisions (SEDs);
- d. regional/division supervisors (ESs II, ESs I) of TLE/TVE;
- e. school administrators, principals/schools heads of public tech-voc high schools;
- f. department heads/head teachers of TVE or related subjects;
- g. administrative officers;
- h. one (1) TVE teacher per school;
- i. heads of TESDA supervised schools;
- j. PTA presidents;
- k. heads of trade/agriculture/fishing/comprehensive national high schools; and
- l. heads of private tech-voc institutions.

Authorized to attend from the TVETF, DepEd Central Office are the directors and personnel/staff, in-charge of programs and projects for TVE.

A registration fee of Three Thousand Six Hundred Pesos (PhP3,600.00) will be charged to each participant inclusive of conference materials, five (5) snacks, three (3) lunch, two (2) dinner. Starting lunch will be on November 18 and ending lunch on November 20, 2010. This is a non-residential (live-out) congress and the registration fee does not cover accommodation.

Pre-registration and payment in cash are encouraged. Check payment should be made payable to **Philippine Association for Vocational Education, Inc.** Pre-registration will ensure the participants of a complete set of conference materials.

Members of the different committees shall be considered participants; hence, they shall pay the registration fee. Moreover, they are authorized to travel two (2) days before Congress.
