FIRST MINDANAO ETHNIC DANCE SEMINAR-WORKSHOP

The College of Sports, Physical Education and Recreation of the Mindanao State University (MSU) in Marawi City will hold the **First Mindanao Ethnic Dance Seminar-Workshop** with the theme, *“Preserving Cultural Identity, Promoting Unity in Diversity, and Propagating Ethnic Dances for Peace and Harmony”* on December 3-5, 2010 at the Dimaporo Gymnasium, MSU, Marawi City.

The objectives of the seminar are to:

- a. provide a venue to showcase the rich, colorful and diverse cultural dances of Mindanao;
- b. preserve and promote their cultural/ethnic dances;
- c. develop competencies in the teaching of their cultural dances among physical educators in all levels; and
- d. propagate the regional cultural dances through an annual ethnic dance seminar-workshop and festival.

The participants to this activity are physical educators in the elementary and secondary schools.

The registration fee of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP2,500.00) will be charged to each participant to cover lunch, snacks, billeting (for participants outside Marawi/Lanao del Sur), kit, handouts, and certificates.
