### **8<sup>TH</sup> INTERNATIONAL EXHIBITION OF BLIND CHILDREN'S PAINTINGS**

The International Exhibition Centre of Children's Paintings in Greece (Study Research) will hold its **8<sup>th</sup> International Exhibition of Blind Children's Paintings** to be held in 2012 at the National Hellenic Research Foundation, Athens, Greece.

The activity aims to spread the message of peace through the art across the world and to recognize the social and artistic development of blind children in the area of painting and civilization.

The children's works of paintings should be drawn on plain painting paper by choice of the painting material: either felt-tipped pens or watercolors or finger paints or temperas.

The deadline for submission of entries is on **November 30, 2011**.

The activity is open to eight (8) to fifteen (15) years of age of blind children in both public and private schools nationwide. Participation is free of charge.

The prizes consisting of a parchment and a medal, will be awarded in a special celebrating Ceremony. All prizes will be of equal complimentary value and will be sent to the children through their country's Embassy of Athens.
