**2011 INTERNATIONAL LEADERSHIP TRAINING FOR EDUCATORS
AND EDUCATIONAL MANAGERS**

The Southeast Asian Institute of Educational Training will hold the **2011 International Leadership Training for Educators and Educational Leaders** with the theme “*Enhancing Leadership Skills for the Internationalization of Education*” on the following dates and venues:

The training aims to:

- a. develop the participants’ skills in dealing with students, colleagues, parents and other school stakeholders;
- b. appreciate educational leadership practices and approaches from the different parts of Southeast Asia and some other parts of the world;
- c. gain insights on how to utilize transformational leadership in a globalized setting; and
- d. equip them with the tools to cope with the different causes of changes.

The topics to be tackled during the training are the following:

- a. Transformational Leadership in the Context of Global Education;
- b. Leadership and the Challenges of Coping to Changes;
- c. Leadership Across Cultures: Leadership Approaches in ASEAN Education; and
- d. Every Teacher, A Leader: Bringing out the Best in Every School.

The speakers shall be led by Dr. Ho Than My Phuong, Deputy Director of SEAMEO-RETRAC; Firth McEachern of Sustainable Cities and Dr. Erico Habijan of NEAP.

The registration fee is Three Thousand Five Hundred Eighty Pesos (PhP3,580.00) each participant which will cover meals (3) and snacks (4), training kit, bags, and certificates. The registration does not include accommodation. The Secretariat shall assist the participants for their accommodation needs. A discounted registration fee of Three Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (PhP3,200.00) shall apply to early registrants.
