**SEMINAR ON APPLYING TECHNOLOGY IN SPECIAL  
EDUCATION (SPED) CLASSROOMS**

The schedule and title of the sessions are as follows:

<b>Session</b>	<b>Time</b>	<b>Description</b>
Technology Use in Special Education	1:00-1:30 p.m.	This session will discuss the role of technology in schools and rationalize its importance in special education. It will highlight the possible technologies (low-and high-tech) and how these can be aligned for intellectual and learning disabilities.
Instructional Strategies for Using Technologies Inside the Classroom	1:30-3:30 p.m.	This session will discuss best practices in using technology for students with special learning needs. It will focus on the concept of Universal Design for Learning applied to technology.
Technology Workshop	3:45-5:00 p.m.	This workshop will focus on developing a technology-integrated lesson plan and designing/developing the corresponding materials for its implementation. It will showcase its technology-integrated lesson plans.

The seminar deals with developing technology enhanced instructional plans for students with special learning needs. Various teaching strategies and electronic materials will be discussed with focus on their applicability for different disabilities. The topics of the seminar will focus on the latest technologies which will help in teaching the children with special needs and how one will define/identify the real problem and the basic sources or the underlying reasons of how and why such behaviors occur/manifest.

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
