The Institute of Development Policy and Management (IOB) of the University of Antwerp offers three (3) full time one-year Master's programs with a high degree of specialization and a distinct focus: **“Development Evaluation and Management,” “Governance and Development”** and **“Globalization and Development.”**

The objective of the Master's programs is to offer a policy-oriented training that incorporates the latest insights from social science disciplines relevant to the development challenge.

The target group consists mainly of mid-career development professionals from low-income and lower middle-income countries whose previous academic backgrounds and career record suggest that they will significantly profit from an advanced international training. The students from developed countries who are already working in or wish to pursue a career in development, and who have some field experiences, are also invited to apply.
