**2012 PHILIPPINE SCIENCE YOUTH CLUB (PSYSC)
NATIONAL SCIENCE CONGRESS**

The *Pambansang Kapisanan ng mga Kabataan Samahan sa Agham* also known as the Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs (PSYSC), Inc. will hold its **2012 Philippine Science Youth Club (PSYSC) National Science Congress** on February 18, 2012 simultaneously at four (4) sites nationwide (one each in National Capital Region (NCR), Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao).

The Congress aims to:

1. develop a scientific community of globally-competitive Science Clubbers and Advisers in the realm of ST&E;
2. promote ST&E Careers to Science clubbers and encourage them to pursue these opportunities (local and global) in the future;
3. ignite different research interests to the Science clubbers and inspire them to do intensive research in their schools; and
4. provide innovative teaching methods to the teachers and update their information on their respective fields.

The participants to this activity are the high school students and Science teachers. Each participating science club can send only ten (10) high school student-representatives but an unlimited number of teachers.

Each participant will be charged a registration fee of One Thousand Pesos (PhP1,000.00) which cover the kits.
