The Philippine Historical Association (PHA) will hold its *Seminar-Workshop* with the theme *Talking Points in History: Jose Rizal, Historical Controversies, and the Multi-Disciplinal World (PHA Lecture Series on Special Topics in Philippine History and Historiography)* on February 1, 2013 at the El Cielito Inn, Baguio City.

1. strengthen the teaching of the Rizal Course;
