SEMINAR-WORKSHOP FOR SOCIAL STUDIES AND HISTORY TEACHERS

In celebration of Andres Bonifacio's 150th Anniversary, the University of Asia and the Pacific Department (UA&P) of History will conduct the *Seminar-Workshop for Social Studies and History Teachers* with the theme *Pag-ibig sa Tinubuang Bayan: A Re-examination of Bonifacio's Ideas on Patriotism, Citizenship and Nation-building* on November 7-9, 2013 at the UA&P Campus, Pearl Drive, Ortigas Center, Pasig City.

The Seminar-Workshop aims to:

1. help them understand the historical and cultural context of Andres Bonifacio, the *Katipunan* and the Revolution;
2. examine the writings of Andres Bonifacio and other primary sources in the context of patriotism; and
3. create awareness, based on the study and analysis of primary sources about Andres Bonifacio's contribution to the emergence of a national consciousness.

The target participants to this activity are Social Studies and History teachers from both public and private schools.
