### 33<sup>RD</sup> PRINCIPALS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM AND NATIONAL BOARD CONFERENCE

The Philippine Elementary School Principals Association (PESPA) will conduct the *33<sup>rd</sup> Principals Development Program and National Board Conference (PDP-NBC)* with the theme *The Artscience Leadership of School Heads* on April 10-12, 2013 at the Tagaytay International Convention Center (TICC), Tagaytay City.

The Conference aims to enable the PESPA officers and members, and other stakeholders to contribute towards excellence in education. Specifically, it aims to:

1. impart to the participants the knowledge and skills they need in conducting research studies;
2. introduce to them the new formula on the computation of school Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE); and
